CROCHET PATTERN

Level of difficulty: Intermediate

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Technic used

This pattern is designed to be crocheted in back-and-forth rounds. You need to close every round with a slip stitch and then turn the work in the opposite direction, unless otherwise stated.

Tip:

To keep the work seamless, do not pull on the slip stitch to tighten it up.

Material used

Wool Any worsted wool

Colors White and Black

Crochet* 3.25 mm / US D 3 hook

Stuffing Poly-fil, Ultra Plush

Yarn Needle **Scissors**



*Since I crochet very tightly, I always use a minimum of 1 size smaller than recommended.

Abbreviations

BL back loop **ch** chain

inc increase **dec** decrease **inv dec** invisible decrease

FL front loop **FP** front post

SC single crochet **dc** double crochet **hdc** half double crochet

slst slip stitch **st** stitch

tog together **[]** number of stitches you should have at end of row

LET'S GET STARTED!

HEAD

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]

Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [18]

Row 4: ch 1, turn, sc in all 18 st, slst [18]

Row 5: ch 1, turn, sc in next st, inc in next st, sc in next 13 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, inc in next st, slst [21]

Row 6: ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next 14 st, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, slst [24]

Row 7: ch 1, turn, sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next 15 st, inc in next st, sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, slst [27]

Row 8: ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, sc in next 16 st, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, slst [30]

Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, inc in next st, sc in next 17 st, inc in next st, sc in next 5 st, inc in next st, slst [33]

Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 st, in BL (inc in next st, sc in next 6 st, inc in next st, sc in next 6 st, inc in next st), sc in next 9 st, slst [36]

Row 11: ch 1, turn, sc in next 10 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 7 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 9 st, slst [39]

Row 12: ch 1, turn, sc in next 10 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 8 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 10 st, slst [42]

Row 13: ch 1, turn, sc in next 10 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 9 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 11 st, slst [45]

Row 14 -22: ch 1, turn, sc in next 45 st, slst [45]

Row 23: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 7 st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [40]

Row 24: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 6 st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [35]

Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on

Row 25: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 5 st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [30]

Row 26: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [25]

Row 27: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [20]

Row 28: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [15]

Row 29: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst [10]

Row 30: ch 1, turn, (inv dec), repeat () 4 times, slst

Fasten off. Weave in yarn tail



BODY

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]

Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [18]

Row 4: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [24]

Row 5: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [30]

Row 6: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [36]

Row 7: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [42]

Row 8-12: ch 1, turn, sc in next 42 st, slst [42]

Row 13: ch 1, turn, sc in next 19 st, (inv dec), repeat (), sc in next 19 st, slst [40]

Row 14: ch 1, turn, sc in next 18 st, (inv dec), repeat (), sc in next 18 st, slst [38]

Row 15-16: ch 1, turn, sc in next 42 st, slst [42]

Row 17: ch 1, turn, sc in next 18 st, inc in next st, sc in next 19 st, slst [39]

Row 18: ch 1, turn, sc in next 17 next, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next 18 st, slst [41]

Row 19-20: ch 1, turn, sc in next 41 st, slst [41]

Row 21: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 37 st, inv dec, slst [39]

Row 22: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 34, inv dec, sc in next st, slst [37]

Row 23: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 32 st, inv dec, sc in next st, slst [35] **Fasten off.**

From inside the work, and going clockwise, count 14 stitches from F.O. and join yarn in that stitch.

Row 24: sc in next 13 st, skip slst, sc in next 14 st [27]

Row 25: ch 1, turn, sc in next 11 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 10 st [25]

Row 26: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 24 st [24]

Row 27: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 9 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 8 st [21]

Row 28: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 7 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 7 st [18]

Row 29: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st [15]

Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on

Row 30: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 4 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 5 st [12]

Row 31: ch 1, turn, (inv dec), repeat () 5 times [6]

Row 32: ch 1, turn, (sc 3 tog), repeat ()

Do not cut yarn, continue with the neck piece.



NECK

Row 1: ch 1, turn, sc in next 8 row-ends, sc in next 7 st, sc in next 8 row-ends, slst [23]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc in next 23 st, slst [23]

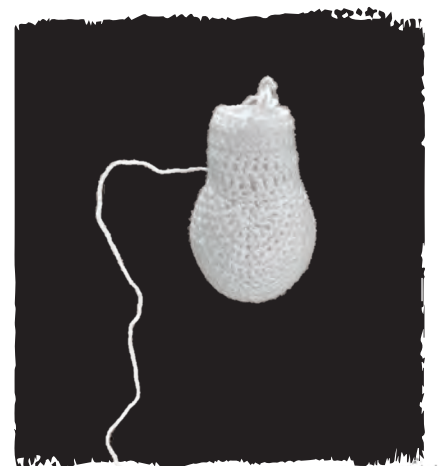
Row 3: ch 2, turn, dc in next 4 st, hdc in next 2 st, sc in next 10 st, hdc in next 2 st, dc in next 5 st, slst [23]

Row 4: ch 2, turn, dc in next 5 st, hdc in next 2 st, sc in next 10 st, hdc in next 2 st, dc in next 4 st, slst [23]

Row 5-9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 23 st [23]

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing the head on.

Finish stuffing.



EYES (make 2) *use black yarn

Chain 4

Row 1: starting with 2nd st from the hook, sc in next 2 st, sc 3 st in next st, sc in next st, sc 2st in next st, slst

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.



EARS (make 2)

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, slst [6]

Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [9]

Row 4: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [12]

Row 5: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [15]

Row 6: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [18]

Row 7: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat (), slst [22]

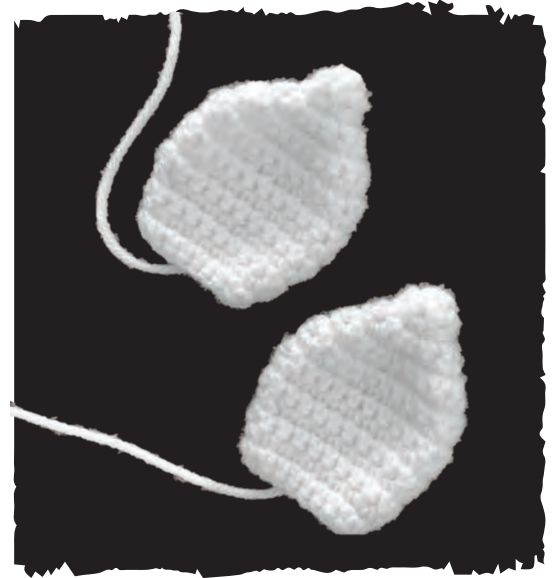
Row 8-12: ch 1, turn, sc in next 22 st [22]

Row 13: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 3 st, inv dec, sc in next 10 st, inv dec, sc in next 3 st, slst [19]

Row 14-15: ch 1, turn, st in next 19 st, slst [19]

Row 16: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 9 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, slst [16]

Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. No stuffing is required.



TAIL

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [9]

Row 3: ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 st, slst [9]

Row 4: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [12]

Row 5: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [15]

Row 6: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [18]

Row 7: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [21]

Row 8-9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 21 st [21]

Row 10: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 5 st, inv dec), repeat () 2 times, slst [18]

Row 11: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [15]

Row 12: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [12]

Row 13: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat 2 () times, slst [9]

Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. Loosely stuff.



BACK LEGS (make 2)

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]

Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st),
repeat () 5 times, slst [18]

Row 4: ch 1, turn, sc in FP of all 18 st, slst [18]

Row 5-6: ch 1, turn, sc in all 18 st, slst [18]

Row 7: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec,
sc in next 7 st, slst [16]

Row 8: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec,
sc in next 5 st, slst [14]

Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [13]

Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [12]

Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on.

Row 11-14: ch 1, turn, sc in all 12, slst [12]

Row 15: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 3 st, inc in next 2 st, sc in next st, inv dec, slst [12]

Row 16: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st, slst [13]

Row 17: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st, slst [14]

Row 18: ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st, inv dec, slst [15]

Row 19-23: ch 1, turn, sc in all 15 st, slst [15]

Row 24: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 5 st, slst [13]

Row 25: ch 1, turn, sc in all 13 st, slst [13]

Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. Firmly stuff.



FRONT LEGS (make 2)

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]

Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]

Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st),
repeat () 5 times, slst [18]

Row 4: ch 1, turn, sc in FP of all 18 st, slst [18]

Row 5-6: ch 1, turn, sc in all 18 st, slst [18]

Row 7: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec,
sc in next 7 st, slst [16]

Row 8: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec,
sc in next 5 st, slst [14]

Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [13]

Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [12]

Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on.

Row 11-25: ch 1, turn, sc in all 12, slst [12]

Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing.





ASSEMBLING THE FAWN!

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Here are some pictured suggestions on how to sew your pieces together.
