## BLANE



## Technic Used

This pattern is designed to be crocheted in back-and-forth rounds. You need to close every round with a slip stitch and then turn the work in the opposite direction, unless otherwise stated.

## - Tip:

To keep the work seamless, do not pull on the slip stitch to tighten it up.

# Material Used 

Wool Any worsted wool
Colors White and Black
Crochet* 3.25 mm / US D 3 hook
Stuffing Poly-fil, Ultra Plush

## Yarn Needle Scissors

*Since I crochet very tightly, I always use a minimum of 1 size smaller than recommended.

## LET'S GET STARTED!

## HEAD

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]
Row 3: ch 1, turn, sc in all 12 st, slst [12]
Row 4. ch 1, turn, inc in next st, sc in next st, inc in next st, sc in next 7 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, slst [15]
Row 5: ch 1, turn, sc in all 15 st, slst [15]
Row 6. ch 1, turn, sc in next st, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next 5 st, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, slst [19]
Row $7:$ ch 1, turn, sc in all 19 st, slst [19]
Row 8. ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next 6 st, inc in next st, sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, slst [23]
Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in all 23 st, slst [23]
Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in next $2 s_{i}$ inc in next st, sc in next $4 s_{i}$ inc in next st, sc in next 7 st, inc in next $s t$, sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, slst [27]
Row 11: ch 1, turn, sc in all 27 st, slst [27]
Row 12: ch 1, turn, (inc in next st, sc in next 8 st), repeat () 2 times, slst [30]
Row 13 -16: ch 1, turn, sc in all 30 st, slst [30]
Row 17: ch 1, turn, sc in both loops of next 9 st, in FL: inc in next st (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in both loops of next 8 st, slst [33]
Row 18: ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 9 st, slst [36]
Row 19: ch 1, turn, sc in next 10 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 7 st, inc in next st), repeat (). sc in next 9 st, slst [39]
Row 20. ch 1, turn, sc in next 10 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 8 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 10 st, slst [42]
Row 21-28: ch 1, turn, sc in next 42 st, slst [42]
Row 29: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 5 st, inv dec), repeat () 5 times, slst [36]
Row 30: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inv dec), repeat () 5 times, slst [24]
Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on
Row 31: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inv dec) repeat () 5 times, slst [24]
Row 32: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inv dec), repeat () 5 times, slst [18]
Row 33: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inv dec) repeat () 5 times, slst [12]
Row 34: ch 1, turn, (inv dec), repeat () 5 times [6]
Fasten off. Weave in yarn tail


## BODY

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]
Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat () 5 times, slst [18]
Row 4: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [24]
Row 5: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [30]
Row 6. ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [36]
Row 7-16: ch 1, turn, sc in next 36 st, slst [36]
Row 17: ch 1, turn, sc in next 17 st, inc in next st, sc in next 18 st, slst [37]
Row 18: ch 1, turn, sc in next 16 st, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next 17 st, slst [39]
Row 19: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 35, inv dec, slst [37]
Row 20. ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 32 st inv dec, sc in next st, slst [ 35]
Row 21: ch 1, turn, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 29 st, inv dec, sc in next st, slst [33]
Fasten off.
From inside the work, and going clockwise, count 13 stitches from F.O. and join yarn in that stitch.
Row 22: sc in next 12 st, skip slst, sc in next 14 st [26]
Row 23: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 9 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 10 st [23]

Row 24: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 22 st [22]
Row 25: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 7 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 8 st [19]
Row 26: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st [16]
Row 27: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 4 st, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, inv dec, sc in next 5 st [13]
Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on
Row 28: ch 1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in next 3 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 4 st [10]
Row 2g: ch 1, turn, (inv dec), repeat () 4 times [5]
Row 30: ch 1, turn, (inv dec), repeat () 2 times, slst in last st
Do not cut yarn, continue with the neck piece.

Row 1: ch 1, turn, sc in next 8 row-ends, sc in next 7 st, sc in next 8 row-ends, slst [23]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc in all 23 st, slst [23]
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the head on. Finish stuffing.


## EYES (make 2) *use white yarn

## Chain 4

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]
Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

## EARS (make 2)

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, slst [6]
Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [9]
Row 4: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat () 2 times, slst [12] Row 5: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [15] Row 6: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat () 2 times, slst [18] Row 7: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat (), sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st). repeat () slst [22]
Row 8-20; ch 1, turn, sc in all 22 st [22]
Row 21: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 3 st, inv dec, sc in next 10 st, inv dec, sc in next 3 st, slst [19]


Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. No stuffing is required.

## TAIL

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc in all 6 st, slst [6]
Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, slst [9]
Row 4: ch 1, turn, sc in all 9 st, slst [9]
Row 5: ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 st, (inc in next st, sc in next st), repeat (), inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, slst [12]


Row 6: ch 1, turn, sc in all 12 st, slst [12]
Row 7: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st), repeat () 2 times, sc in next 3 st, slst [15]
Row 8: ch 1, turn, sc in all 15, slst [15]
Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 st (inv dec, sc in next st) repeat () 2 times, inv dec, sc in next 2 st slst [11]
Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in all 11 st [11]
Row 11: ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 st, (inc in next st, sc in next st),
repeat () 2 times, inc in next st, sc in next 2 st, slst [15]
Row 12: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat () 3 times, sc in next 3 st, slst [19]
Row 13: ch 1, turn, sc in all 19 st, slst [19]
Row 14: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inv dec) repeat () 3 times, $s c$ in next 3 st, slst [15]
Row 15: ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 st, (inv dec, sc in next st) repeat () 2 times,
inv dec, sc in next 2 st, slst [11]
Row 16: ch 1, turn, sc in all 11 st, slst [11]
Row 17: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inv dec), repeat (), sc in next 3 st, slst [g]
Row 18: ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 st, slst [g]
Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. Stuff.

## BACK PAWS (make 2)

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]
Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [18]
Row 4 : ch 1, turn, sc in FP of all 18 st, slst [18]
Row 5-6: ch 1, turn, sc in all 18 st, slst [18]
Row 7: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 7 st, slst [16]
Row 8: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 5 st, slst [14]

Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [13]
Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [12]
Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on.
Row 11: ch 1, turn, sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next st, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st, inv dec, slst [ 13]
Row 12: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next $2 s_{t}$ (inc in next st, sc in next st) repeat (), inc in next st, sc in next 4 st. slst [15]
Row 13: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 2 st, (inc in next st, sc in next st), repeat () 2 times, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st, slst [17]
Row 14: ch 1, turn, inv dec, sc in next 4 st, (inc in next st, sc in next 2 st), repeat (), inc in next st, sc in next 5 st, slst [20]
Row 15-16: ch 1, turn, sc in all 20 st, slst [20]
Row 17: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat () 3 times, slst [24]
Row 18: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 4 st, inv dec) repeat () 3 times, slst [20]
Row 19: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inv dec) repeat () 3 times, slst [16]
Row 20: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 2 st, inv dec), repeat () 3 times, slst [12]
Row 21: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inv dec), repeat () 3 times, slst [8]
Row 22: ch 1, turn, inv dec in all 4 st slst
Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. Firmly stuff.

## FRONT PAWS (make 2)

Row 1: sc 6 in magic circle, slst [6]
Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc in all 6 st, slst [12]
Row 3: ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, inc in next st), repeat () 5 times, slst [18]
Row 4: ch 1, turn, sc in FP of all 18 sti slst [18]


Row 5-6: ch 1, turn, sc in all 18 st, slst [18]
Row 7: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 7 st, slst [16] Row 8: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next st, inv dec, sc in next 5 st, slst [14]
Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [13]
Row 10: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, inv dec, sc in next 6 st, slst [12]

## Start stuffing gradually as you crochet on,

Row 11-15: ch 1, turn, sc in all 18 st, slst [18]
Row 16: ch 1, turn, (sc in next 3 st, inv dec) repeat (), sc in next 2 st, slst [10]
Row 17-18: ch 1, turn, sc in all 10 st, slst [10]
Fasten off. Leave yarn tail for sewing. Pinch ends together and sews them closed.
